- Akasaka Shukuba shiryou shitsu (local historical exhibition room, including Ukiyo-e paintings of those times) Otowashougaigakushukan 2F (Otowa Lifelong Learning Center 2F) Free entry. Open 9:00 to 17:00 closed on Mondays, end of year and new year holidays.
- See the beautiful wild cherry trees at Chohuku temple. See the cycads at Josen temple. (Featured in Ando Hiroshige's 53 stations of the Tokaido painting "Akasaka")

- This street represents the place of the 36th prosperous post town on the legendary 53 stations of the Tokai Road.

Mt. Miyaji hiking

Take in the wonderful view from the top of the mountain.

30 min hike up the mountain from parking area (picnic tables as rest stops along the way) 90 min climb down the mountain (to the old Tokaido roadside)

Torin temple

This is a temple where the important historical figure levasu Tokugawa rested. (When he was lord of Mikawa)



Goyu pine tree lined street museum. Here aretefacts from the 35th post town, Goyu Shuku, from the historical 53 stations of the Tokai Road are displayed. (Free entry. Open 10:00-12:30, 13:30-16:00. Closed Mondays and end of year/new year holiday period.)

To/from Toyokawa Inari 600 yen (prices current as of 2017) Lunch: approx. 500-2,500 yen At an altitude of 362m, the pleasant walking trail and nearby parking area make Mt. Miyaji an easy and enjoyable hike. On a clear day even as far as Mt. Fuji can be seen from the summit! In spring, visitors can also enjoy the beautiful Mt. Miyaji white Koaburatsutsuji flowers. Mt. Miyaji also holds an annual "Autumn leaves festival "in late November.

Get all the information you need here about climbing Mt. Hongu, including maps. A guide can be booked in advance through the Toyokawa Tourist Information Center. Picnic lunch can be bought at the nearby convenience store before your climb.



Relax and refresh in the soothing hot spring baths. Restaurant also available. Open 10:00-22:00, closed Wednesdays (or the follwing day if Wednesday is a public holiday).

Yamanba no ashiato (Footprint of the mountain witch - Station 39) Here a rock can be found called, "a footprint of a mountainwitch".

There is a dip in the surface of the rock and it is believed if the climber puts their foot in the dip, their fatigue will be eased.

Umanoseiwa (Horseback Rock, Stations 25-28) Halfway up the mountain, climbers navigate a steep, rocky ridge. However soon afterward, just before station 28 climbers are rewarded with rest at a pavillion with a scenic view.







Oshimizu (Station 42)

There is a cool mountain spring
"chozuya"here for climbers to use.
(A "chozuya" is a place where
people cleanse their mouths and
hands before entering a shrine).

Hitsukiiwa (Station 28) Here a big rock called Hitsukiiwa is found. On the rock the letters "Hitsuki" (日月)are visible. It is said if climbers trace them, they will be able to write letters better.





Nagayama tozan guchi (Station 1) A big torii (Shrine gate) built in the Tokugawa era marks the start of the climb to the top of Mt. Hongu. Mt.Hongu


